

## **Global Startup Challenge 2010 rules**

1. GSC may be entered by any natural persons from Europe
2. To take part in GSC you have to be at least 18 years old
3. GSC may be entered with both projects in their idea stage and already implemented projects.
4. Only projects that aim for the global market will be considered.
5. Submitters retain ownership of their projects - Global Startup Challenge claims no rights to them.
6. Projects should be submitted before June 16th 2010.
7. Submissions are made through the GSC website: [www.globstar2010.com](http://www.globstar2010.com).
8. Projects go through an initial verification process, and a maximum of 10 enterprises will be invited to enter the GSC.
9. A project team may consist of a maximum of 3 members, including programmers.
10. Appraisal and qualification of projects is handled by people representing the GSC's organizers.
11. People responsible for projects will be notified of their qualification for the GSC between June 16th and 23rd 2010.
12. The chosen project teams will be invited to Szczecin. The date of arrival is June 30th 2010.
13. The GSC workshop starts on July 1st and will last until August 31st 2010.
14. The site of the workshop is in the offices of the Science and Technology Park of Szczecin.
15. Every participant is guaranteed to receive office space and equipment (computers excluded), internet access and accommodation throughout the duration of the workshop.
16. People that qualify for the GSC workshop will receive the full rule list, as well as detailed rules for possible creation of joint companies with the GSC organizers.
17. Any complaints concerning the competition shall be handled by the Organizers. Complaints should be sent as a certified letter to one of the Organizers within 7 days of the event that the complaint regards. Decisions regarding the complaints shall be made within 7 days of receiving. The outcome shall be announced by the Organizers, immediately after a decision is made, by mail, in a letter sent to the specified return address.
18. The Organizers retain the right to cancel the competition, should such an action be necessary due to technical problems, a lawful court judgement, an administrative decision, a change in legislation or a higher power, as understood by the Civil Law Codex. Information about a cancellation of the competition shall be released by the Organizers in the way specified for spread information about the competition.
